We just come back from 6 weeks in Morocco...

Cap Rhir (a good place to see Aoudads): 2 one day and 3 individuals next day + 1 red fox

6,5 km south Tafraout on R104 a good place to see Cuvier's gazelles: 2 one day and 7 the next day.

Barbaries Ground Squirrels almost every days from south Essaouira to Assa.

Egyptian Mongoose : one in fields along mouth of the wadi Massa (it's seem to be a good place for this mammal) and one north Chefchaouen.

Eurasian Wild Pig: one during night drive from Amtoudi and many evidences in north of the country.

Crushed mammals: some Hedgehogs, one Lesser Egyptian Jerboa at Assa and one Gerbil sp at west of Tifnit.

Some latrines of Genets. In particular one impressive in an abandoned kasbah in the oasis of Taliouine.

During a night drive at Amtoudi a rat with long nose and long tail quickly crossed the road in front of the car: I presume North African Elephant-shrew, but not sure!

The fenced reserves of Arrouais and Rokein in Massa NP protect beautiful species of mammals: not to miss!
