

South Vietnam, 1 week (February, March 2018)

3 Days Cat tien

1 Days Mang Den

2 Days Bach Ma

1 Days Son Tra (Danang peninsula)

- 1- Asian Red-Cheeked Squirrel (*Dremomys rufigenis*) : Common in top Bach Ma
- 2- Pallas's Squirell (*Callosciurus erythraeus*) : Common in Cat Tien (around restaurant)
- 3- Small Asian mongoose (*Herpestes javanicus*) : one on the road Son Tra Peninsula
- 4- Slender-tailed threeshrew : One close to gibbon's enclosure Cat tien
- 5- Sambar (*Cervus unicolor*) : One during morning walk Cat tien
- 6- Indian muntjac (*Muntiacus vaginalis*) : One during morning walk Cat tien
- 7- Black-shanked douc (*Pygathrix nigriceps*) : One group crocodile lake trail
- 8- Red-shanked douc (*Pygathrix nemaeus*) : Few in Bach Ma close to the top, many North Son Tra peninsula
- 9- Yellow-cheeked Gibbon (*Hylobates gabriellae*) : Three close to gibbon enclosure
- 10- Annamese silvered langur (*Trachypithecus margarita*) : One group Cat Tien, Crocodile lake trail
- *Grey-shanked douc (*Pygathrix cinerea*) : Not found in Mang Den but people see quite often around check point and 1km after small village 15km north MangDen
- 11- Crab-eating macaque (*Macaca fascicularis*) : +++ Cat tien, one group Son Tra peninsula

12- Assam macaque (*Macaca assamensis*) : Two groups Son Tra peninsula

13- Lesser brown horseshoe bat (*Rhinolophus stheno*) : +++ Bach Ma cave, trail to the top
