3-6TH July 2016



13 Mammal species (Bat species excluded) including 2 Solitary or Chacoan Peccaries, Puma, Jaguar, Geoffrey's Cat, Ocelot, Lowland Tapir.



MAMMAL SPECIES LIST INCLUDES

3 Banded Armadillo: Many sightings including freshly killed by Jaguars

Chacoan Titi Monkey: multiple sightings during the trip

Lowland Tapir: 2 Sightings, one in a lagoon and one at night during night drive.

Jaguar: 10am daytime sighting on road, large male.

Puma: 2 Sightings, one at 1715 large male and the 2nd was an extending sighting at 0805 along the road, we observed for over 20 minutes.

Silvery Marmoset: Sighting of a small group in a lagoon 1630

Ocelot: 2 Sightings, including a brief daytime sighting of one sitting in the sun.

Geoffrey's Cat: One daytime sighting on the main highway to the park

Crab Eating Fox: Multiple day and night sightings

Azaras Agouti: 1 afternoon Sighting leaving the Park



Grey Brocket Deer: 2 Sightings by road

Conovers Tuco Tuco: One brief daytime sighting on road

South American Coati: Large Group outside Kaa Iya National Park.
