5	Olive Colobus	<i>Piliocolobus verus</i>	
6	Western Red Colobus	<i>Piliocolobus badius badius</i>	
7	Sooty Mangabey	<i>Cercocebus atys</i>	
8	Diana Monkey	<i>Cercopithecus diana</i>	
9	Campbell's Monkey	<i>Cercopithecus campbelli</i>	
10	Lesser Spot-nosed Monkey	<i>Cercopithecus petaurista</i>	
11	West African Potto	<i>Perodicticus potto</i>	3 guests & spotter, but not guide. Group was split

12	Demidoff's Dwarf Galago	<i>Galagoides demidovii</i>	
13	Slender-tailed Squirrel	<i>Allosciurus aubinnii</i>	
14	Fire-footed Rope Squirrel	<i>Funisciurus pyrropus</i>	
15	Red-legged Sun Squirrel	<i>Heliosciurus rufobrachium</i>	
16	Forest Giant Squirrel	<i>Protoxerus stangeri</i>	
17	Green Bush Squirrel	<i>Paraxerus poensis</i>	Unconfirmed - one guest (Phil Davidson) saw and self-identified
18	Nagtaglas's African Dormouse	<i>Graphiurus nagtaglasii</i>	
19	Thick-tailed African Dormouse	<i>Graphiurus crassicaudatus</i>	smaller than <i>G. nagtaglasii</i> and different colour. Phil may have photos
20	Emin's Pouched Rat	<i>Cricetomys eminii</i>	
21	Thicket Rat	<i>Grammomys buntingi/kuru</i>	
22	Swamp Rat	<i>Malacomys cansdalei/edwardsi</i>	Found dead/drowned in foot bath basin at Chimp Camp
23	Lord Derby's Anomalure	<i>Anomalurus derbianus</i>	
24	Franquet's Epauletted Fruit Bat	<i>Epomops franqueti</i>	and regular roost above water, which seems to be typical of this species.
25	Johnston's Genet	<i>Genetta johnstoni</i>	
26	Unknown Genet	<i>Genetta sp.</i>	Narrow banded & white-tipped tail. Fairly sure it wasn't an Oyan, based on size and face

27	Marsh Mongoose	<i>Atilax paludinosus</i>	Seen by 3 guests & spotter, but not guide
28	White-bellied Tree Pangolin	<i>Phataginus tricuspis</i>	
29	Red River Hog	<i>Potamochoerus porcus</i>	Tracks & feeding signs only 1 seen leaving dense vegetation in forest on a night stakeout. Lots of tracks & dung
30	Pygmy Hippo	<i>Choeropsis liberiensis</i>	
31	Forest Buffalo	<i>Syncerus caffer nanus</i>	Tracks only
32	Lowland Bongo	<i>Tragelaphus eurycerus eurycerus</i>	Tracks only
33	Maxwell's Duiker	<i>Philantomba maxwelli</i>	
34	Jentink's Duiker	<i>Cephalophus jentinki</i>	Tracks only
35	Water Chevrotain	<i>Hyemoschus aquaticus</i>	the river bank. Too large & bulky for domestic cat, too small for leopard. By the time we got the
