HEADLINE RARE TARGET

PANTANAL CAT - THREE DEDICATED NIGHT SEARCHES IN BENI

A specialist expedition across Bolivia's lowlands

Four distinct wildlife zones | intensive field time | maximum 6 guests

Designed for serious mammalwatchers, this fast-paced itinerary is built around wild felines of every size - not only Jaguar and Puma, but also difficult small cats such as Jaguarundi, Ocelot, Pantanal Cat and the rare possibility of Geoffroy's Cat. The route combines the Gran Chaco of Kaa Iya, intensive feline searching at Jaguarland, targeted primate and nocturnal mammal work around Santa Cruz, and a Beni sector built around repeated Pantanal Cat searches. Wildlife is fully wild and never guaranteed; the emphasis is on field effort, flexibility and time in habitat.

KEY MAMMAL TARGETS

Cats, primates and lowland specialists

Jaguar - Puma - Ocelot - Jaguarundi - Pantanal Cat (rare target) - Geoffroy's Cat (rare possibility) - Chaco, White-lipped and Collared Peccaries - Brazilian Tapir - Giant Anteater - Southern Tamandua - Bolivian Red Howler Monkey - Bolivian Squirrel Monkey - Azara's Night Monkey - White-eared Titi - Black-tailed Marmoset - Brown-throated Three-toed Sloth - Marsh Deer - Capybara - Tayra - Southern Three-banded Armadillo - Coati - Crab-eating Raccoon - Bolivian River Dolphin.

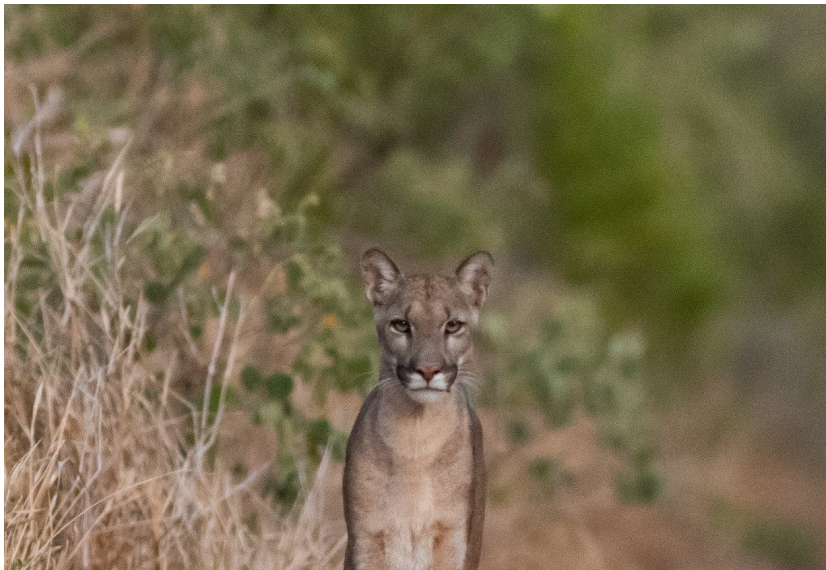
DAY 0 | SAT 10 JUL

Arrival in Santa Cruz

NO MEALS INCLUDED

Days 1-4 | intensive Chaco mammalwatching

CORE TARGETS

Puma is one of the principal Kaa Iya targets, alongside Jaguar, Ocelot and Jaguarundi. Other key mammals include all three peccaries - Chaco, White-lipped and Collared - Brazilian Tapir, Southern Three-banded Armadillo, Tayra, Gray Brocket Deer and other Gran Chaco species. Geoffroy's Cat remains a rare possibility. Facilities inside the park are basic and the emphasis is on field access rather than comfort.



DAY 1 | SUN 11 JUL

Santa Cruz to Kaa Iya

Overland transfer from Santa Cruz into Kaa Iya. Begin wildlife searching on arrival and continue into the evening as conditions allow.

DAY 2 | MON 12 JUL

Kaa Iya National Park

Full-day and evening searches along the park roads and tracks. Long field days are expected and the schedule remains flexible.

DAY 3 | TUE 13 JUL

Kaa Iya National Park

Another intensive day and night of mammalwatching, adapting effort to tracks, sightings and recent activity.

ALL MEALS INCLUDED

DAY 4 | WED 14 JUL

Kaa Iya to Santa Cruz

Final morning searching, then return to Santa Cruz. Overnight at Hampton by Hilton, Santa Cruz.

Days 5-8 | intensive feline watching - Jaguar, Ocelot & Jaguarundi

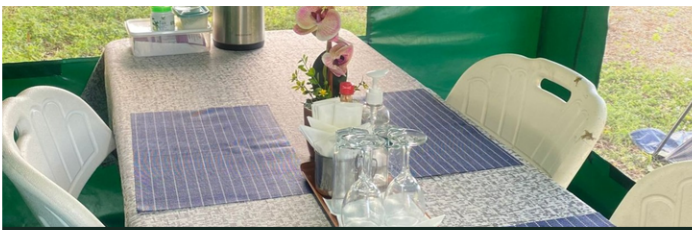

Jaguarundi - key small-feline target

Jaguarland is one of the strongest parts of the expedition for felines, with repeated searches for Jaguar and Ocelot and a particularly important focus on Jaguarundi - one of the hardest South American cats to encounter. Jaguarundi is treated as a major target, not a secondary species. Additional mammals can include Brown-throated Three-toed Sloth, Marsh Deer, Capybara, Bolivian Red Howler Monkey, Bolivian Squirrel Monkey, Brazilian Tapir, Giant Anteater (possible), Coati, Collared Peccary, Tayra, armadillos and other nocturnal mammals.

DAY 5 | THU 15 JUL

Santa Cruz to Jaguarland

Transfer to the private reserve and begin afternoon/evening wildlife searching.

ALL MEALS INCLUDED

DAY 6 | FRI 16 JUL

Jaguarland

Morning, afternoon and nocturnal wildlife searches, adapting to recent animal activity.

ALL MEALS INCLUDED

DAY 7 | SAT 17 JUL

Jaguarland

Another full day of flexible cat and mammal searching, including night work.

ALL MEALS INCLUDED

DAY 8 | SUN 18 JUL

Return + Santa Cruz night tour

Final Jaguarland activities, return to Santa Cruz, then approximately 8 PM-midnight nocturnal mammal search.

SANTA CRUZ NOCTURNAL TOUR

Approx. 4 hours | usually 8 PM-midnight

Targeted searching for Philander/four-eyed opossums, multiple mouse-opossum species, Azara's Night Monkey, Brazilian Porcupine and other nocturnal wildlife, with additional chances for snakes and owls.

DAY 9 | MON 19 JUL

Santa Cruz wildlife + flight to Trinidad

Morning wildlife tour targeting White-eared Titi Monkey, Black-tailed Marmoset and Brown-throated Three-toed Sloth, with Red-legged Seriema possible. Transfer to the airport and fly to Trinidad. Boutique hotel. Dinner followed by Pantanal Cat Night Search 1.

BENI: PANTANAL CAT FOCUS

Three dedicated night searches | 4-5 hours each | usually 8 PM-midnight/1 AM

THE MAIN FOCUS IN BENI

The Pantanal Cat is one of the most important targets of the entire expedition. Across three consecutive nights we devote sustained search effort to this elusive small cat. Each search lasts approximately 4-5 hours, normally from around 8:00 PM until midnight or 1:00 AM, depending on conditions and animal activity. Sightings remain fully wild and cannot be guaranteed.

DAY 10 | TUE 20 JUL

Bolivian River Dolphin + Night Search 2

Full-day river and wetland excursion with Bolivian River Dolphin as the principal target. Dinner, then the second 4-5 hour dedicated Pantanal Cat search. Night drives can also produce Giant Anteater, Crab-eating Raccoon, Crab-eating Fox and other savannah mammals.

DAY 11 | WED 21 JUL

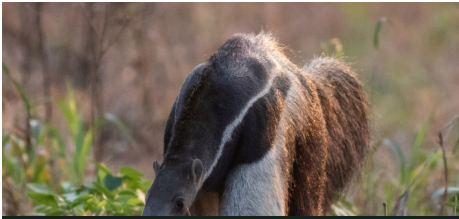
Blue-throated Macaw + Night Search 3

Full-day Blue-throated Macaw excursion and Beni wildlife, followed after dinner by the third 4-5 hour dedicated Pantanal Cat search.

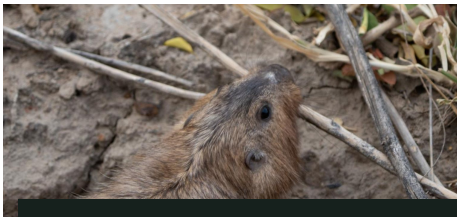

OPPORTUNISTIC HERPING

Interesting reptiles along the route

Although this is primarily a mammalwatching expedition, night drives and fieldwork can also produce reptiles. Potential highlights include Tricolour Hognose Snake, Neotropical Rattlesnake, Red-tailed Boa and the endemic Bolivian Anaconda. These are opportunistic sightings rather than guaranteed targets.

DAY 12 | THU 22 JUL

Trinidad to Santa Cruz

Morning at leisure, then afternoon flight to Santa Cruz. Overnight in a 4-star hotel.

Breakfast, then private transfer to Viru Viru International Airport for onward travel.
