## Madagascar November 2022 3 weeks / 44 species

Madagascar is having a moment it seems, with five or six fall 2022 reports out already or due to be released soon. We did not intend to be part of a trend—our travel dates had been determined by school and work. We were a team of four: Charles Hood, José Gabriel Martínez-Fonseca, Mike Richardson, and Mike's partner, Sarah Winch. For all of us, it was our first trip here.
